Fluorescence technology is an optical (or light) based technology that can aid in visualization of oral mucosal abnormalities, such as oral cancer and pre-cancer.

### The Examination

OralID® is a simple, 2 minute examination that aids your doctor in visualization of oral mucosal abnormalities, such as oral cancer and pre-cancer.

If you are 17 or older, the United States CDC recommends an annual oral cancer screening.







5 Year Survival Rate at Stage of Discovery




## **HPV EXPOSURE: NEW ORAL CANCER RISK FACTOR**

HPV, **transmitted primarily through sexual contact**, is the cause of the fastest growing Oral Cancer population under the age of 45. HPV is also responsible for a **15x increase** in oral cancer diagnosis among this same age group.

#### HOW LIKELY AM I TO GET CANCER CAUSED BY HPV?



Men are now more than **2x as likely** to develop oral cancer

HPV-related cancers are **6–7x more common** in men than women

Those with 6 or more oral sex partners are **8.6x more likely** than those who have never had oral sex
